- Captain Steve White joined the Marine Exchange as the Executive Director in September of 2021 after serving 31 years in the Coast Guard. His last assignment was Sector Commander and Captain of the Port for Southeast Alaska.
- Steve served 7 tours throughout Alaska including assignments to 4 ships, 2 of which he served as the Commanding Officer.
- His other tours included serving on a Coast Guard Atlantic Area ship, service
 with the Joint Forces Maritime Component Command, serving with Navy and
 Coast Guard forces in the Middle East and various other Coast Guard units.
 He has patrolled the Gulf of Alaska, Bering Seas, Arctic, Pacific, and Atlantic
 Oceans.
- Steve sat on the North Pacific Fisheries Management Council as the Coast Guard representative, served as the Enforcement Chair for the North Pacific Anadromous Fish Commission and was the Incident Commander for the Coast Guard's Arctic Operations.
