- Since 20218, Rear Admiral David Dermanelian, USCG, has served as the Assistant Commandant for C4IT (CG-6).
- For a year during his current assignment, he was dual hatted as Commander of Coast Guard Cyber Command and CG-6.
- In a previous two-year assignment, Rear Admiral Dermanelian served as the Director of Training and Exercises (J7) at U.S. Cyber Command. There he developed joint training and assessment standards and orchestrated over two dozen large scale exercises for the Cyber Mission Forces, partner nations, inter agencies, all Services, National Guard, Reserves, and private industry.
- Prior to that he served in ten unique assignments ranging from research & development, Chief Information Security Officer, commanding communications stations that provided maritime 911 services, college electrical engineering instructor, and chief engineer developing mission enabling electronic and information technology solutions for the USCG fleet.
- As a cadet, he sailed the Coast Guard Cutter EAGLE to Australia.
- A native of Michigan, Rear Admiral Dermanelian graduated from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy with a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering and from The George Washington University with a Master of Science in Electrical Engineering.
