- Commander Nassar is currently a Division Chief at the Coast Guard's Office of Command, Control, Communications, Computer, Combat, and Intel (C5I) Capabilities, leading requirements development to deliver Enterprise-wide C5I to cutter, boat, aircraft, intelligence centers, and command centers.
- Commander Nassar is responsible for validating, prioritizing, and allocating resources in support of mission needs supporting communications and infrastructure requirements. Additionally, he ensures and verifies Coast Guard Enterprise solutions meet operational requirements.
- Prior to this role, Commander Nassar was the Assistant Branch Chief for the Coast Guard's Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C4ISR) Branch at the Research and Development Center (RDC) in New London, CT. In this role, he led technical teams to explore emerging technology, conducted analyses to determine its applicability to Coast Guard, and produced products and strategies to inform Coast Guard acquisition efforts.
- Commander Nassar has also served as both Engineering Officer and Operations Officer at the Communications Command, as well as a technical analyst of the PNT electronic navigation program.
- Commander Nassar's underway experience includes serving as Electronics Division Officer and Assistant Engineer Officer on the now decommissioned 378' Cutter BOUTWELL conducting counter-narcotics and other interdiction operations.
- Commander Nassar graduated from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy with a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering and from the Naval Postgraduate School with a Master of Science in Electrical Engineering. He is currently pursuing a Master's in Business Administration with a focus on Security Technology Transition from the George Washington University.
